***FURTHER DETAILS**

Reproductive genetic carrier screening (RGCS) is a test used to determine if there is an increased risk of having a child affected by a genetic condition. Limited RGCS tests for a small number of common genetic conditions. Expanded RGCS tests for a larger number of genetic conditions. We are all carriers for genetic conditions and carriers are usually completely healthy. Individuals having expanded RGCS panels a carrier for one or more of the conditions screened for.

If selecting this donor, you will be required to have an "individual" reproductive genetic carrier screening (RGCS) test via a company called Fulgent. The donor has already been screened for 500+ recessive genetic conditions and is a carrier for one or more if the conditions screened. You will be screened for the same recessive genetic conditions that the donor is a carrier for, plus additional recessive and X-linked genetic conditions. You will be informed which conditions your donor is found to carry and which conditions you are found to carry and will be advised if you have a low reproductive risk, or increased risk.

The results will take 4-6 weeks. A member of the Genetics team will contact you once you have selected a donor to discuss the required test in more detail, and order testing for you. You are welcome to contact the Genetics team if you have questions prior to making your selection.

Please note, if you receive an increased risk result you will need to select a new donor. In this situation, the genetics team will review your options to determine if there is an alternative donor for you to consider. If the new donor has had a different RGCS test, you will need to have additional RGCS. This will incur additional fees and time to wait for the new result.
